It is my proud privilege to put before you the achievements and happenings of this academic year. Our students have been scaling new heights in every field. Today we have a total of 6363 students: 2043 in Senior College, 2351 in Professional courses and 1969 in Junior College.

We strive to achieve Quality in all spheres of life. The academic performance of our students is excellent. Our BCom Degree passing percentage is 89.43, the University results being 46.49 per cent. Shaikh Tabbassum stood first this year with 97.00 per cent

The BMS Degree passing percentage is 49.00 per cent, Sherley Rose Shyam Sundar topped the class. The BAF Degree passing percentage is 87.14 per cent and Kandoi Nisha topped the class.

The BBI Degree passing percentage is 88.68 and Purohit Jaya topped the class.

BFM passing percentage is 80.95% and Yadav Deep Ajay kumar topped the class.

The BMM Degree passing percentage is 80.00. Singh Manashi Santosh Rashmi topped the class of BMM Advertising while Mehta Payal Chetan Sangita topped the class of BMM Journalism.

BSc.(I.T.) Degree passing percentage is 65%. Vikshit Jain topped the class.

The M.Com-II (Accountancy) passing percentage is 78.94 and Manisha Kathayat topped the class. The M.Com (Management) passing percentage is 67.74 and Khushboo Chaurasia topped the class. Our passing percentage for every course is greater than that of the University Passing Percentage.

The HSC college result this year is 96.29 percent. Om Narendra Tripathi stood first this year.

Our students not only excel in academics but also in the cultural field and sports. We promote all round development of students by encouraging them to take part in curricular and extra-curricular activities. Our students participated and bagged several prizes at the various intercollegiate competitions conducted by the University and the city colleges.

The Dalmia Lions Utsav has been setting benchmarks every year. This year we had 75 colleges participating in the 37 events. We provide the youth a platform to showcase their talent and creativity. This mega event saw a great number of celebrities from the media and film world that were judges and special guests motivating the youth to excel.

Our Degree Football team is making great progress in the last four years; today we are in the top 8 of University of Mumbai Football team. Amit Yadav of SYJC has won the Silver medal in Boxing at DSO District level. We are proud of our Boxers who have won the bronze medals – Sachin Vishwakarma, Shivam Kanojiya, Yogesh Rajpurohit, Pankaj Pandey and Hitesh kumar Yadav.

Under the able guidance of our Sports In-charge Mr. Rajesh Maurya assisted by Mr. Aditya Choudhary & Mr. Vivek Yadav the sports department is doing a commendable job. Our sports persons will definitely win many more prizes in the years to come under their able guidance

Alphonse our former student choreographed Street dances and Bollywood Dances and we won in 17 colleges. Krishna Leela & Daangi team, won laurels for us at 04 colleges. Our Fashion show team won at 04 colleges. At the National Academy of Event Management and Development our college won overall 3rd position at the National Level. At the Youth festival organized by University of Mumbai, Ms. Divya Tiwari & Ms. Indrayani represented our college and bagged prizes for Fine arts.

I am more than happy to inform you all, that the Cultural Association has been producing Event managers, and our student Mr. Siddesh Masurkar and Mr. Rutvik Poojary won the Event Manager of the year Award that was awarded by National Institute of Event Management. This year we organized two workshops and are planning to organize two student research conferences. This year our teacher – Dr. Mahendra Pachadkar completed his Doctorate in Philosophy on the topic 'Consumer Protection in Human Rights Perspective with reference to recent Judicial trends in context of Maharashtra State' from JJTU under the guidance of Dr. S. V. Munde, Department of Law, University of Mumbai.

We are proud to say that from this year we have started a Research Centre affiliated to the University of Mumbai, it has gained recognition for PhD (Commerce) Degree Course in the subject of Accountancy. Along with Dr. Shiva Padme, Dr. Sunita Tidke and myself, Dr. N. N. Pandey we now also have Dr. Kiran Mane who is given recognition as Ph.D Guide by University of Mumbai.
