Initiatives and activities of IQAC 2015-16: Setting Benchmarks

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell undertook the following Initiatives:

- 1) Theme of the year decided unanimously were:
 - a) Eco-friendly initiatives to be taken by all HODs:

Two sided printing to save papers was encouraged. Also printing in BOLD and BIG FONTS were sparingly used to minimize the cost on PRINT CARTIDGE. The theme needs further deliberation for all-wing execution.

- b) Inculcating reading habits among the students:
 - Book review and students' seminar were organized on this theme. The details are included in Department of Commerce and Library reports. All examination results analysis from the exam committee as well as university results were collected by IQAC for the purpose of uniform data collection and data dissemination.
- 2) Feed back on faculty was collected from students of aided and professional courses with the help of in house software for the academic year 2015-2016
- 3) IQAC prepared the documents for BEST COLLEGE and sent the same to University on 5th Dec 2015.
- 4) It was resolved by IQAC that feedback be obtained from moderators from the examination committee, delegates' participating at seminars and visitors. The concerned members have done the needful.
- 5) IQAC collected reports of all committees for the academic year 2015-16. Files for next 5 years have been prepared and seminar reports have been collected from the conveners of concerned departments. The departments which have not submitted the reports have been told to complete them in this academic year.
- 6) Power point presentations were scheduled on teaching, learning and research. Presentation on teaching, learning and evaluation was carried out in the auditorium by the in-charges of Criterion II of teaching, learning and evaluation. This initiative will be continued in the next academic year too.
- 7) A community project conducted in the academic year 2014-15 was continued at Osarvira in DahanuTaluka in this academic year 2015-16.
- 8) IQAC facilitated Career Advancement Scheme for promotion of 5 faculty members.
