The college practices a teaching methodology which concentrates on imparting education through a student centric approach. Project method: The students are given projects in many courses such as Foundation Course, Advertising, Export Management, etc. which helps in stimulation of their interest in the concerned subject. It also develops their thinking skills and allows exchange of views.

The institution has the essential equipments to support the faculty members and students. The IT department uses these facilities for their respective subjects. Google Classroom is used as a Learning Management System to connect with students, providing them with study materials, assignments, conducting quizzes, solving their queries and getting feedback. Whats App groups are created to share materials and lecture updates and connect with the students. JAM boards are also used by the teachers to optimise the TLP process. Various teaching learning tools such as Edmodo, Kahoot is used to make the learning process a fun-filled activity. Flipped classroom technique is also used by teachers wherein students

are given pdf, audio and video learning material that is later used for discussion in the classroom.

Experiential learning: The department of Business Communication and BAMMC organises students conference, a conference for the students, by the students. The research papers are presented by students on contemporary topics to enrich their learning experience.
